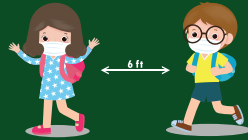
12 COMPONENTS TO COVID PREVENTION

SAFETY FIRST!



STUDENT PODS / COHORTS

Students remain in one room, limit commingling, reduce movement. Teachers move, limit mixing of groups.



SOCIAL DISTANCING

Modified layout of classrooms to ensure 6 feet apart, organized entrance and dismissal.



HYGIENE STATIONS

Sanitation stations in every classroom, with step-by-step instruction, required use entering and leaving.



MASKS & PPE

Masks required by faculty and age-appropriate students indoors at all times with additional PPE purchased.



DESK PARTITIONS

Modified layout of classrooms to Each desk outfitted with plexiglass partitions.



VENTILATION / AIR PURIFIERS

New air purifiers for areas that do not have windows. Improving HVAC to increase circulation and cleanliness.



MANAGED TRAFFIC / SIGNAGE

One direction flow in hallways, separate elementary and middle school and increased signage on walls.



USE OF SCHOOL FOOTPRINT

Effective use of 37,300 square footage of indoor space +20 acres of outdoor space for 250 students.



ISOLATION ROOM

New additional health room for isolating students or faculty suspected of COVID-19 symptoms.



CLEANING & DISINFECTING

Twice daily cleaning of high touch and evening disinfecting, and 24-hour close-off of areas used by sick students.



ENGAGEMENT APP

Contactless registration and virtual volunteering made possible via new school engagement app.



COMMUNICATIONS

School-to-parent communications focused on at-home hygiene, timely information on health concerns.
